




Welcome to Amsterdam Airport




Map by A.J. Enschedé (1870), after the map by Symen Fransz. van der Merwen from 1578




Second lowest airport in the world at -/- 4.5 m


The first lowest is Rotterdam Airport at -/- 5 m








In 1949, Jan Dellaert presents his revolutionary idea. It was realised in 1967






